

DAY 101- 1. Review

2. Spell words on day 100 from memory.
3. Dictate words on day 101.
4. Direct activity with capitalization rules.
5. Ask each child to write sentences as directed.

Ask each child to draw a line between the subject and the predicate of each sentence. Ask them to draw a circle around each simple subject and simple predicate.

EXAMPLE:

Our wonderful, fantastic, enjoyable teacher provides many interesting, challenging and fun things for us to do each day.

(The vertical line should be placed between “teacher” and “provides.” A circle should be around “teacher” and “provides.”)

6. Ask each child to write the letters of the alphabet and to do penmanship practice.
7. Ask each child to correct and rewrite the descriptive paragraph from yesterday.
8. Direct reading activities.
